

GO-LAB CONTEST 2016: PROMOTING MULTIDISCIPLINARY SCIENCE TEACHING

The Go-Lab contest aims to inspire teachers from European countries and encourage them to implement in their class multidisciplinary activities which involve the use of online labs. In the framework of the contest teachers will have the opportunity to combine their imagination and creativity in order to experiment with their students using the Go-Lab online labs.

The contest is targeting teachers from different European countries and invites them to demonstrate how they used the Go-Lab activities in combination with the Go-Lab "Big Ideas of Science" in order to make their science lessons more multidisciplinary and make connections between different science disciplines.

Two teachers from each participating country will be awarded with a six-day trip to Greece in the summer of 2016 to attend the Go-Lab summer school.

1. Visit the website of the contest and make a registration.
2. Read the general information of the contest in order to get an overall idea.
3. Select an activity and implement it with your students.
4. Prepare your entry so as to present how you used the Go-Lab tools in order to make your science lesson more multidisciplinary and make connections between different science disciplines.
5. Submit your entry to *golab@ea.gr* by April 30th.
